\$7,500.00 Canadian Soroptimist Grants for Women

APPLICATION FORM

The Soroptimist Foundation of Canada annually offers several \$7,500 grants to female graduate students in Canada to assist them with university studies that will qualify them for careers that will improve the quality of women's lives. Examples include but are not limited to: providing medical services, providing legal counselling and assistance, counselling mature women entering or reentering the labour market, counselling women in crisis, counselling and training women for nontraditional employment, and positions in women's centres.

To be eligible, an applicant must be:

- (1) A female.
- (2) A Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
- (3) An accepted registrant in a full-time graduate studies program (Masters or PhD) or professional program at a similar level (medicine, law) in an accredited Canadian university, **at the time of the application deadline.**

Note: Your university must belong to the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada (AUCC). A list of these universities can be found on their website www.aucc.ca.

Note ineligible conditions: BA level studies, a medical residency program, attending a college that is not affiliated with a Canadian university.

- (4) Pursuing a course of studies which will lead to a career mainly of service to women.
- (5) Spending a minimum of two years in such a career in Canada.
- (6) Intending to use the award for academic studies in the academic year following receipt of it.
- (7) Contributing to your community through Volunteer service.
- (8) Needing financial assistance.

An applicant must meet all eight requirements to qualify for a Soroptimist grant. An applicant may apply more than once, and may receive a Grant in more than one year, but no more than two consecutive years. Soroptimist members are not eligible although family members may apply.

An applicant may apply in either English or French.

Completed applications and all required documents must be received no later than January 31st to be considered. Soroptimist Foundation of Canada decision on completeness and eligibility, including time of receipt, is final.

Students with out-of-country transcripts must either – supply original transcripts in sealed envelopes from that country or – have their current Canadian university that has accepted their registration supply them with a copy of their out-of-country transcripts in a sealed envelope from the Canadian university, with the signature of the university official or the university seal on the flap.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

In order for your application to be considered, it must be received by January 31st. Express post or courier is recommended. Material sent by FAX or electronically is not acceptable.

The required documents are:

- a fully completed and signed application form
- proof of Canadian citizenship or landed immigrant status (photocopy acceptable)
- official transcripts from post-secondary educational institutions attended
- proof of university registration (if applicable)
- three letters of reference
- completed financial statement
- your personal statement

All documents should be sent by the applicant and must be submitted in a confidential manner, in separate sealed envelopes with the sender's signature or the university seal over the seal of the envelope flap, as the case may require. If it is not possible for the applicant to include a required document, then the sender must ensure confidentiality and use a sealed envelope with the senders signature or seal over the seal of the envelope flap. Everything must be received by January 31st. If any required document is not received by that date, the application will not be considered. No exceptions will be made.
